DOING AN INTERVIEW...

- a) Get their name, age, and where they are from. - Church, town, school, pathfinder club etc. If you record what school they are from make sure you get what grade they are in at that school.
- b) Ask your question and then wait for their answer. Make sure to give them enough time before going on to the next question.
- c) For the purpose of news writing, such as would go in the Gleaner, your interview doesn't have to be long or in-depth. Just a few questions will do.

GENERAL QUESTIONS TO ASK...

- 1) How were you involved in the event/project/experience, etc.?
- 2) What affect did the experience have on you?
- 3) Tell me about someone you met or an experience you had.

QUESTIONS TO ASK ABOUT THE TLT WEEKEND...

- 1) Have you enjoyed the weekend so far?
- 2) What has been your favorite part so far?
- 3) Have you been to a TLT training convention before?
- 4) Why are you in the TLT program and what do you expect to learn/gain from the experience?
- 5) Ask two questions of your own. Make sure you write the questions and the answers down so you can share them.

QUESTIONS TO ASK ABOUT GOING DOOR TO DOOR...

- 1) Have you done door to door projects before?
- 2) Did you feel shy when you got to the door? If so, how do you handle it?
- 3) Did you have any interesting experiences when you were out today?
- 4) What do you think about when you're faced with a person who you know doesn't know Jesus?
- 5) Ask two questions of your own. Make sure you write the questions and the answers down so you can share them.
